Hat, headband and scarf

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Quality:

Alaska River (Gründl)

80 % acrylic, 20 % wool

100 g / 75 m

Size:

Hat:

Size M: head circumference approx. 53 cm - 56 cm

Size L: head circumference approx. 57 cm - 60 cm

Scarf: length: approx. 180 cm, width: approx. 25 cm

Headband, size M: head circumference approx. 53 cm - 56 cm

Required quantity:

Hat (with pompom): approx. 100 g col. 11 (raspberry mix)

Scarf: approx. 400 g col. 11 (raspberry mix)

Headband: approx. 50 g col. 11 (raspberry mix)

Needle thickness:

Circular knitting needle: 10.0 + 12.0

Pattern: (number of stitches divisible by 4 + 2 est)

Basic pattern: est, alternately k 2 st ri, 2 st le, est, continually rep. this r

Cable pattern: est, * 2 st ri, in the process k the 2nd st in front of the 1st st (and work in front of the 1st st), then k the 1st st and let both st slip from the needle, 2 st le, from * continually rep., est

Hat:

Cuff pattern: k 1 r in the cuff pattern (= rsr) and 1 r cable pattern, continually rep. these 2 r

Scarf:

Sequence: 2 r in the basic pattern, 1 r in the cable pattern (= rsr), 2 r in the basic pattern and 1 r in the cable pattern (= wsr). Continually rep. these 6 r

Edge stitch: k ri at the start of the row, sl. at the end of the row as if k ri, thread in front of the needle.

Headband: see sequence and edge stitch for scarf

Tension sample (basic pattern, slightly stretched):

Needle thickness 10: 12 st x 15 r = 10 cm x 10 cm

Needle thickness 12: 10 st x 12 r = 10 cm x 10 cm

Pattern:

Hat: (varying instructions for size L indicated in brackets)

The hat is knit in open rsr and wsr. Cast on 44 (48) st and 2 est with needle thickness 10, and k 5 cm (= 9 r) in the cuff pattern, start with a wsr. Then continue to work in basic pattern. At a total height of 15.5 (17) cm (= 25 (27) r), k 1 more rsr in the cable pattern and 1 wsr in the basic pattern. Then decr. between the est as follows:

28th (30th) r: always k tog. ri the 2 ri st (= 35 (38) st)

29th (31st) r: k the st as they appear

30th (32nd) r: always k tog. le the 2 le st (= 24 (26) st)

31st (33rd) r: k the st as they appear

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32nd (34th) r: always k tog. 2 ri st (= 13 (14) st)

33rd (35th) r: always k tog. 2 le st (including est), end with 1 le st (= 7 st)

Sew together these remaining 7 st with the current working thread. Close the rear seam flat. Make a pompom with a diameter of approx. 9 cm and sew it to the hat.

Scarf:

Cast on 24 st and 2 est with needle thickness 12 and k 11 r in the basic pattern, begin with a wsr.

Now 160 cm (= 192 r) in the scarf sequence and then k 12 r in the basic pattern. Then c off the st, in the process k the st as they appear.

Headband:

Cast on 12 st and 2 est with needle thickness 10 and k 46 cm (= 68 r) in the scarf sequence. Then c off the st as they appear. Twist the band 1 x and sew together evenly at the back.

Abbreviations:

col. = colour • st = stitch(es) • r = row(s) • est = edge stitch(es) • ri = right • le = left • rsr = right-side row(s) • wsr = wrong-side row(s) • k tog. = knit together • c off = cast off • rep. = repeat • k = knit • decr. = decrease
